Re: NZRegistry

Understandably most of us are not keen on paperwork, but to make the New Zealand Llama Registry (known as NZRegistry) a legitimate, reliable database we must be able to verify what has been recorded, which means we must have written records.

The Birth Certificates enclosed are a temporary step towards the Registry Certificates. The Registry Certificates will be on card and have a five generation pedigree on them. This current Birth Certificate contains the information the Owner/Breeder has submitted and it can be used to Transfer Ownership or in the unfortunate circumstances Death Notification.

If you have a Contact Details, Breeder Prefix and Owner Code Registration Form with your paperwork this means that I do not have a copy on file for you. I would really appreciate if at some stage you could complete and return for our files.

If you are a Breeder I have also enclosed Birth Notification (for newborns) and Certificates of Service (for those providing or receiving outside services) and possibly also Llama Listing Forms (for older llamas). There is also a separate Transfer of Ownership/Death Notification form available on request.

All forms can be downloaded from the NZLA website www.llamas.org.nz or can be e-mailed to you on request.

If you need corrections or additions to the issued Birth Certificates please return with necessary corrections. If you have sold/gifted the llama, please sign the necessary back and send to the new owner for them to complete and return so transfer can be recorded.
